## Main Purpose of the Role

To provide high-quality teaching and learning for pupils across subjects for KS3 students who are unable to attend mainstream school. The role involves supporting students who are unable to attend due to medical needs, ensuring continuity of education and supporting their emotional well-being. These students will cover a range of ability, with many previously being out of school for long periods on time.

## **Duties and Responsibilities**

- Plan and deliver engaging and accessible lessons tailored to individual learning needs (KS3)
- Differentiate instruction to accommodate a wide range of abilities and medical needs.
- Assess, record, and report on student progress regularly.
- Provide an inclusive classroom incorporating excellent SEND practice
- Work collaboratively with other professionals
- Build positive relationships with pupils, parents/carers and colleagues to support learning and wellbeing
- Contribute to the development of the curriculum and enrichment activities
- Maintain a safe and nurturing classroom environment
- Uphold school policies and procedures, including those relating to safeguarding and child protection
- Promote emotional resilience and positive mental health.
- Provide an inclusive classroom incorporating excellent SEND practice
